

Law Enforcement Requests

Tools for Humanity (TFH) is a US company based in San Francisco, California. As a US company, TFH responds to all properly served law enforcement process from US-based law enforcement agencies. Such agents should submit requests via our law enforcement portal, which is available at <https://app.kodexglobal.com/tools-for-humanity/signin>.

Law enforcement authorities outside of the United States should follow the applicable process for obtaining user data from U.S. companies, such as that specified in the relevant mutual legal assistance treaty (MLAT).

TFH also accepts law enforcement process from Germany, Singapore, and Kenya, as it has entities in each of these locations. The entities in these countries have no user data.

Please note that the World Foundation is a separate entity from TFH. Tools for Humanity and TFH understands that the World Foundation does not have access to any user data. You can find more information about the World Foundation [here](#).
